# THIS WEEK . . . MISSION UPDATE

Highlights of the last report from Bart & Amy Horton, posted in the north hall. . .

**Clive Evan Horton:** "This is the hardest thing I have to do in my job." Those were the words a specialist told us one morning in July as Amy & Clive were having a sonogram. Apparently Clive had a "transient phenomenon" that decided to transient itself out of the picture. Clive had an enlarged ventricle in his brain at 22 weeks that made our "specialists" suggest abortion as the only alternative to an extremely difficult life. God was gracious and healed Clive, making him our little miracle baby. Our Christmas present came on Thanksgiving! He is healthy, happy and even sleeping once in a while. We love him and are so thankful to God for His wonderful gift we can call our son. **A November Weekend in Zurich:** Bart was blessed by our sending agency, Grace Ministries International, to be taken to a conference with several of our agency's missionaries in Europe. The symposium was an opportunity for Bart to learn from many older, wiser, experienced missionaries who were excited to share their wisdom with him. It was an invaluable time that reinforced to Bart the importance of humility, servanthood, and family ministry on the mission field.

**The Skinny on Support:** We have two main goals for this year: First, gain the necessary partners that will help us to sustain the Lord's ministry in Lebanon. Second, in the Lord's timing, be in Lebanon by September of 2010. Just writing those two goals out makes my hands shake. How exciting to think that we (you -- our supporters & us) could see the beginning of our plans take shape this year!

In order to help us along that path, many people have been so kind to us with their commitments of prayer and support, and one time gifts for the ministry in Lebanon. There have even been several people ask about year-end giving. While we appreciate it all year-round (there is humor there if you look for it), we understand year end giving can be beneficial in several ways for you, and for the ministry, so if this giving method fits your needs, go for it! However, we already have several organizations, donors and foundations willing to help us with our large one-time out going expenses. Our main need is for Kingdom Partners willing to stand in the gap with us and sacrifice each month, so that we can see the Lord's ministry grow in the Arab World. **The Horton's Sending Agency:** Grace Ministries International (GMI) is the sending agency for Bart and Amy in their ministry in Lebanon. Some facts about GMI that lead FHCC to partner with them:

At its heart, GMI is absolutely committed to the inerrancy, authority, and sufficiency of Scripture. As such, we look to God's Word alone in determining our theology of missions. The following the focus of our missionary efforts.

- **Leadership Training:** Leadership training takes place on the mission field primarily through international training centers. Established by a union of Grace Church missionaries and national church leaders, these schools are similar to a Bible institute or seminary.
- **Church Strengthening:** Church strengthening brings a missionary alongside an existing church to support and strengthen its ministry in the community.
- **Church Planting:** Church planting takes place where there is no national evangelical church.
- **Bible Translation:** Bible translation brings the Word of God to a people group that does not yet have the Bible in their own language.
