Children's Ministry Changes

On Promotion Sunday (August 15), Flint Hills Christian Church will implement some changes to the children's ministry. God has blessed us with a growing number of young ones. Therefore, we need to make some changes in order to best provide appropriate teacher to child ratios in each class.

At 9 a.m. we will provide the following Sunday School classes in the Youth Center: (same locations)

- 2's to 5's Class – Room 102
- Kindergarten to 2nd Grade Class – Room 104
- 3rd Grade to 6th Grade Class – Room 103

During the Sunday service, children from Kindergarten to 6th grade will sit with their parents in the service. Then, after fellowship break and during the sermon, Kids Worship will encompass Kindergarten to 4th grade in 2 separate rooms. 5th and 6th grades will remain in the service and listen to the sermon with their parents.

Kids Worship will be divided accordingly in the Harvest House:

- Kindergarten to 1st Grade – Fireside Room
- 2nd Grade to 4th Grade – Room 108

However, Kids Worship will NOT occur during the 2nd and 5th Sundays of the month. Children will remain in the Sunday Service for the sermon on those weeks.

At 10:15 a.m. we will provide the following classes in the Youth Center: (same locations)

- 2's to 3's class – Room 102
- 4's and 5's class – Room 201
